Tall spikes host a constellation of star-like florets with definitive centers. Flower clusters are at the top of long, leafless stems.

NAME: Ornithogalum Dubium, Snake Flower, or Sun Star.

LASTING: Blossoms will last an amazing 2 to 3 weeks as the blooms progressively open from the base of the cluster up to the tip.

HEIGHT: 16" to 22"+.

FAMILY ROOTS: Native to South Africa. Common relatives: onion, Alstroemeria, Hyacinth and Tulip.

HISTORY: The bulbs have been prepared and used as food in the Old World and it is believed the ancient Greeks ate the young shoots as a substitute for asparagus.

FARM FRESH: Dubium is typically grown in hoop houses.

DISPLAY: A truly fabulous and artistic cut flower. A dramatic enhancement to an arrangement.

CARE & HANDLING: Upon arrival cut stems and place into a clean container with fresh, tepid water with fresh flower food solution. Keep in cool location out of direct sunlight and drafts. Replenish water as needed.
